Notice of Public Hearing and
Public Comment Period for Duval County
Pre-Application for Preservation & Reinvestment Initiative for
Community Enhancement (PRICE)

## **PURPOSE:**

Duval County is giving notice of a public hearing which will be held to obtain citizen input necessary for The FY2023 Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) grant application for \$22,000,000.00. The Price Grant supports communities in their efforts to maintain, protect, and stabilize manufactured housing and manufactured housing communities (MHCs). The PRICE Main funding will support low- and moderate-income homeowners with manufactured housing units and manufactured housing communities with critical investments such as repairs, infrastructure improvements, and upgrades to increase resilience.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Manufactured housing is a critical piece of the nation's affordable housing stock that provides a home to over 22 million Americans. Manufactured housing and manufactured housing communities (MHCs) face significant challenges to affordability, resilience, infrastructure, and maintenance that are exacerbated by state titling and local zoning laws, financial pressures from landowners or investors, and extreme weather, natural hazards, and disaster events.

## **PUBLIC MEETING DETAILS:**

The County invites all interested persons to a Public Hearing to provide input and discuss the Preservation & Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) grant application. The public hearing is part of the required 15-day public comment period for the pre-application process. The 15-day comment period will run from May 16, 2024 to May 31, 2024.
